10: MAORI VILLAGES BY M. BROWN	In New Zealand especially in the district called Hot Springs, there are hot springs and pools with boiling water caused by steam coming from inside the earth. Admiral de Ruyter of the Dutch Navy was one of the greatest seamen of the world and perhaps the greatest of Holland. He won several victories over the English during the 17 th Century. 13: MY LOST DOLLAR BY STEPHEN LEACOCK	This essay says a word in defence of honesty. Here, Stephen Leacock seeks to entertain the reader and not to enlighten him. 14: OPERATION INDIAN OCEAN BY MIHIR SEN	Mihir Sen, the celebrated Indian swimmer, has to his credit a magnificent record of swimming feats, which include the swimming of the English Channel and of the 40 mile long strait of the Dardanellas. The passage here gives an exciting account of his swim across the Palk Straits, the stretch of sea between India and Sri Lanka. 6: THE WELL OF ST. KEYNE BY ROBERT SOUTHEY	This is an amusing story about a well in Cornwall (in Britain). There was an old belief that if either of a married couple drank the water from the well before the other did, he or she would rule the home. The story is built upon this belief. The well bore the name of the woman saint, St. Keyne. People believed that it was she who had made the spring of the well appear and blessed it with the special power. 8: JAMES HONEYMAN BY W.H. AUDEN	In this poem W. H. Auden, a poet of this generation, tells the story of a scientific genius who makes an invention that destroys him and his family. The story brings out the irony of scientific progress, namely the terrible power it has to destroy man altogether side by side with its power to raise the quality of his life. 9: NIGHT OF THE SCORPION BY NISSIM EZEKIEL	In this poem Nissim Ezekiel, who has published several books of verse, makes vivid poetry out of an ordinary incident, namely a woman being stung by a scorpion with all the goings-on that follow. 10: IF BY RUDYARD KIPLING	Rudyard Kipling was a British author who wrote short stories and poems, many of them with India as background. He sets forth here a philosophy of steadfastness and courageous action in face of the turns and twists of life. 




