

Essence of the Discussion:




Essence of the Discussion:

**Group I:** Yes. Over 500M people in the world, spread out across 101 countries speak English today. It is a widespread language in India and also the official language in 35 countries (including India).



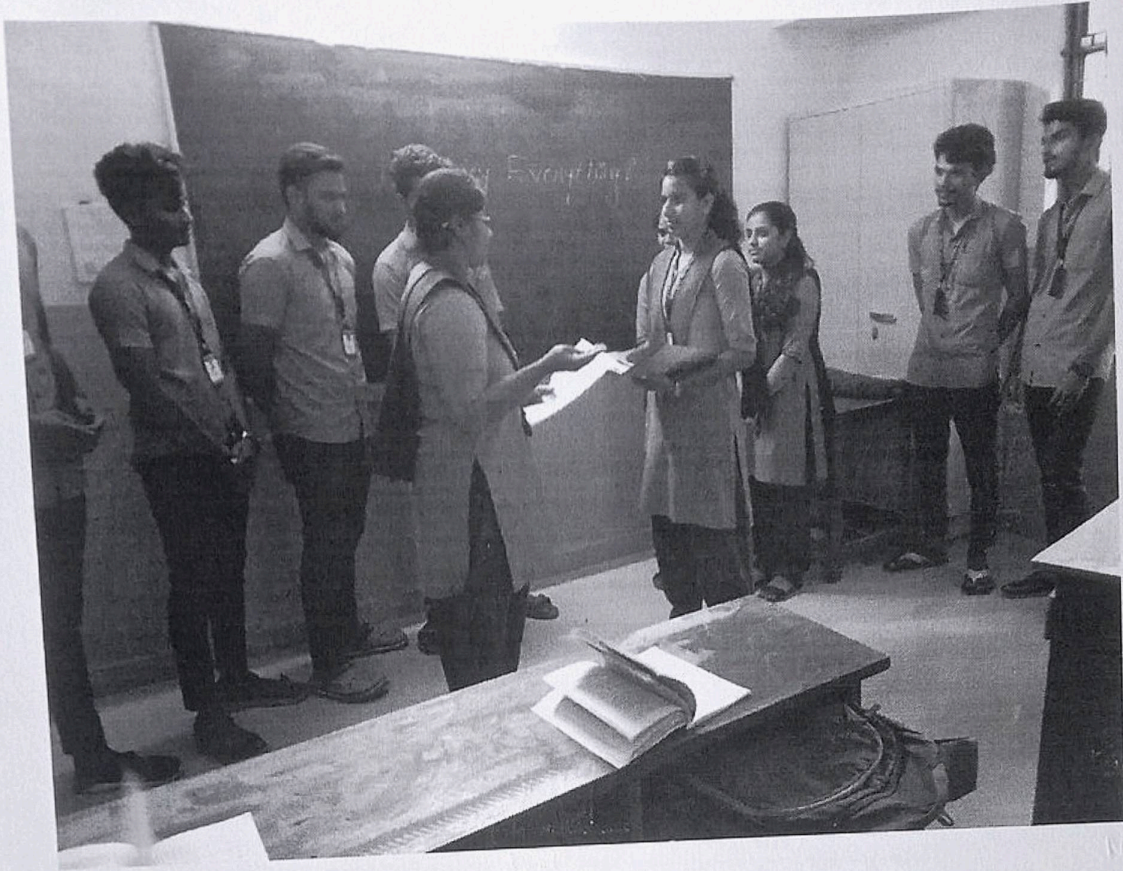

Topic: Is Money Everything?


Essence of the Discussion:


