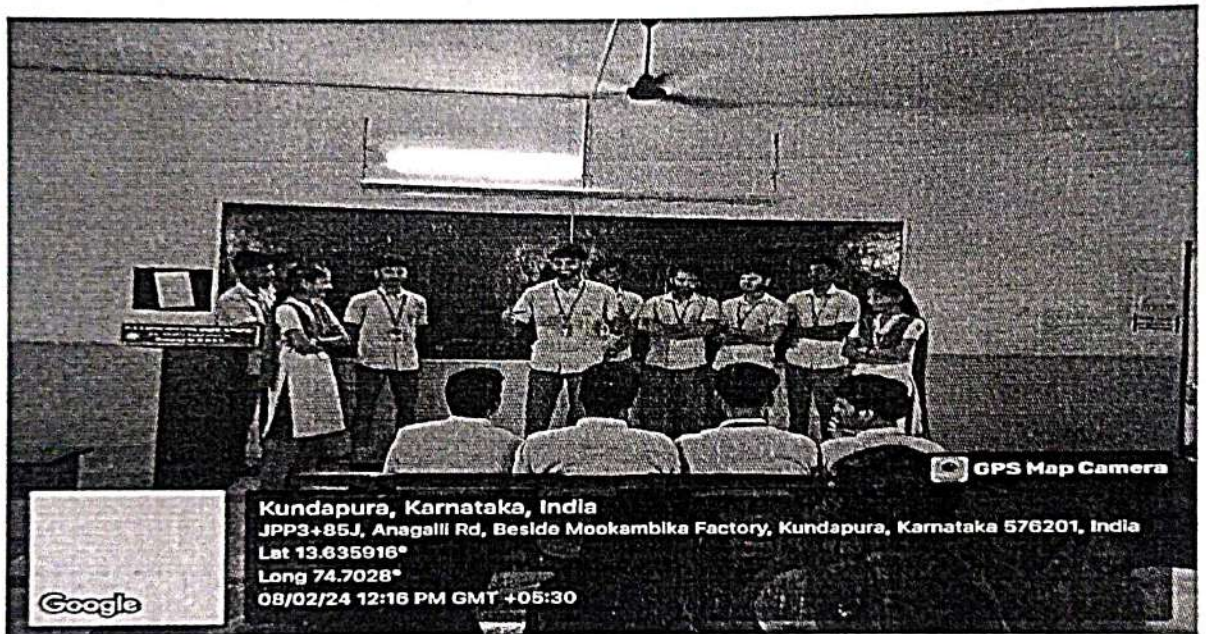
Essence of the Discussion:

Crime prevention: It aids in detecting and preventing cyber crimes like hacking and identity theft.



Group I: Books:

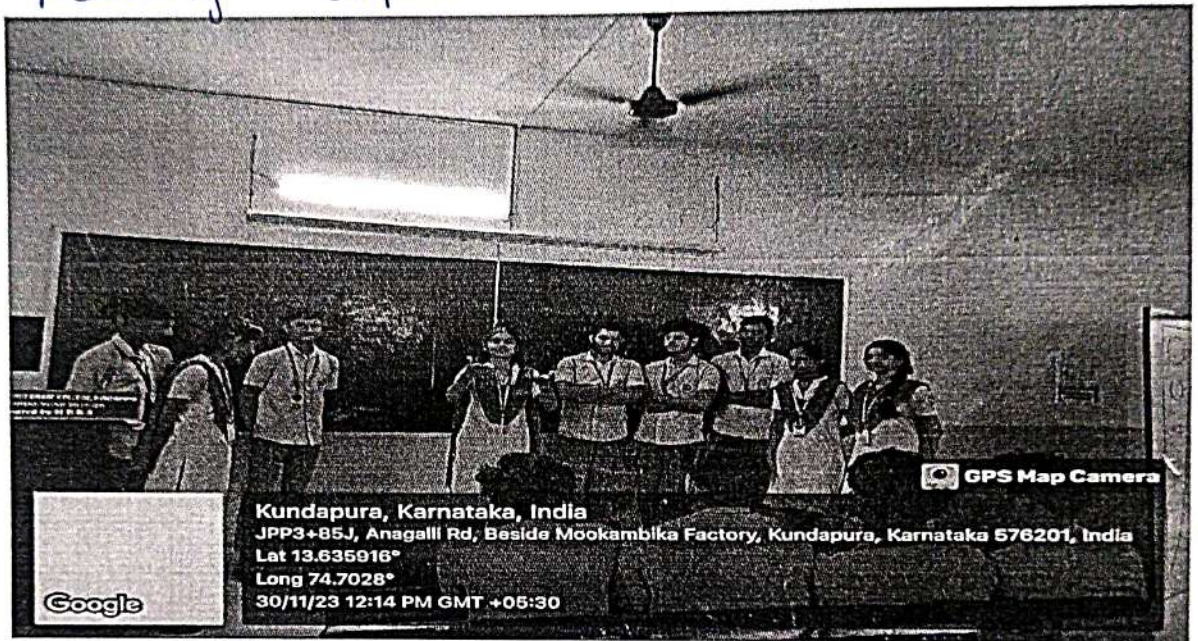
- Tactile Experience: physical books offer a sensory experience, with texture, smell & visual appeal

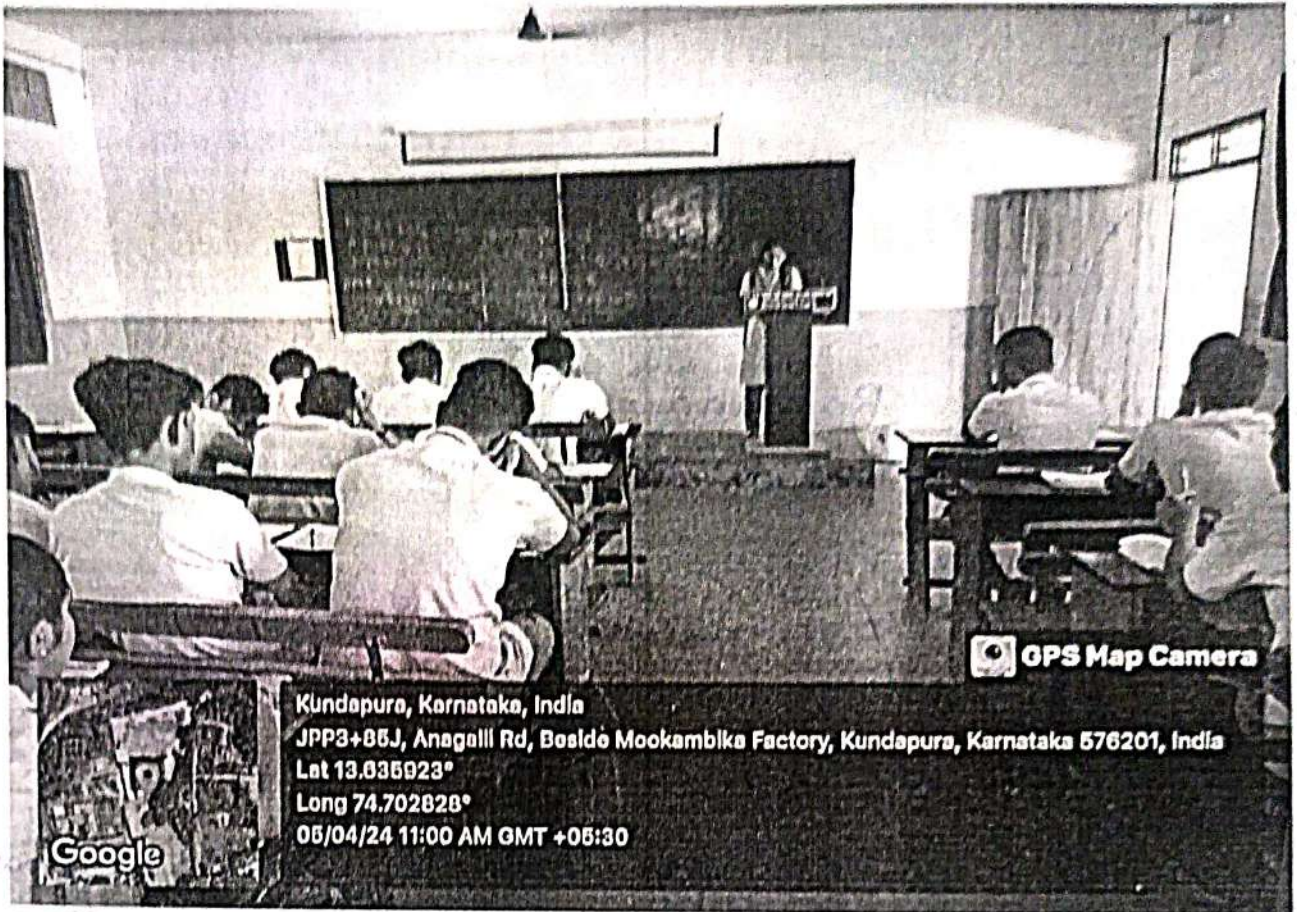

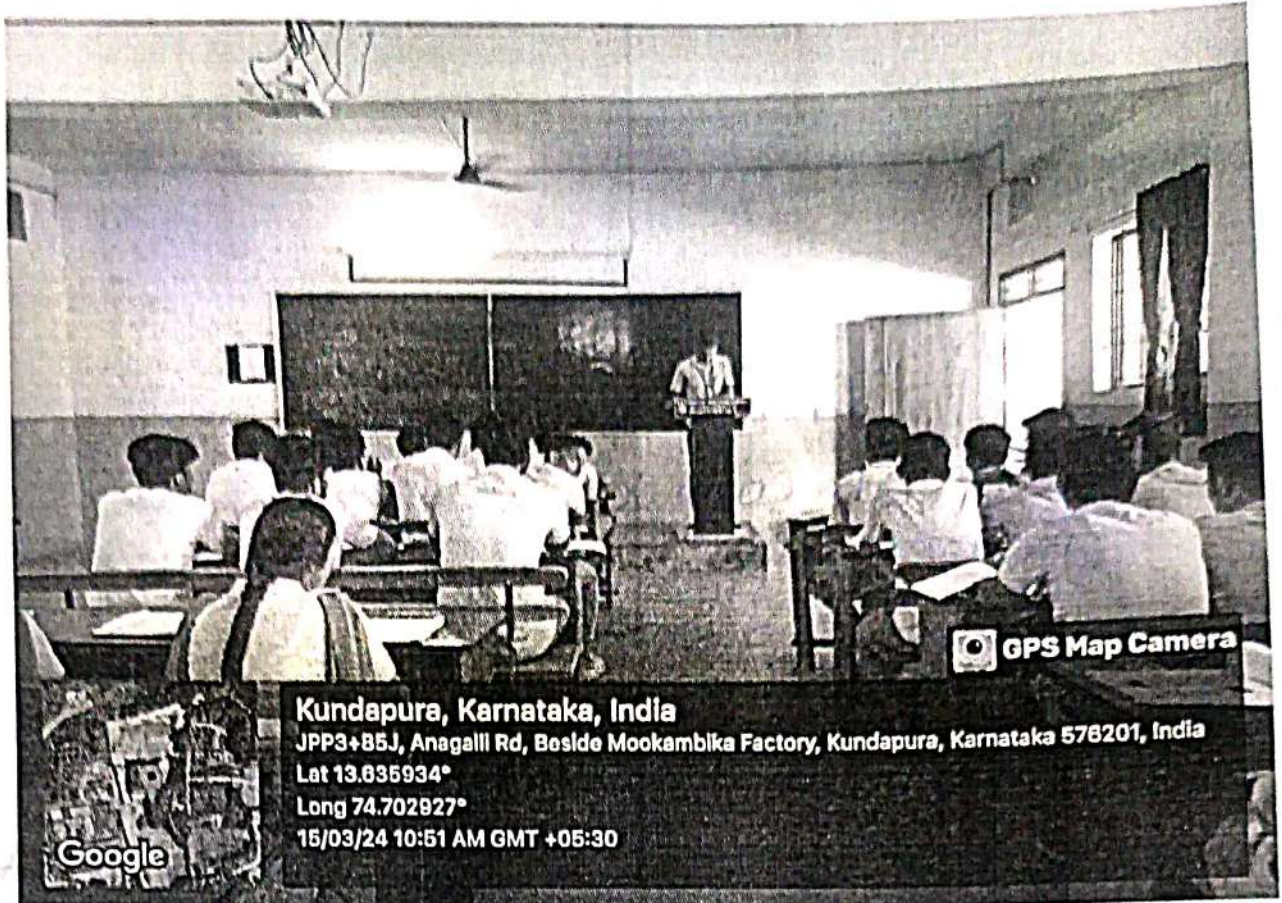
