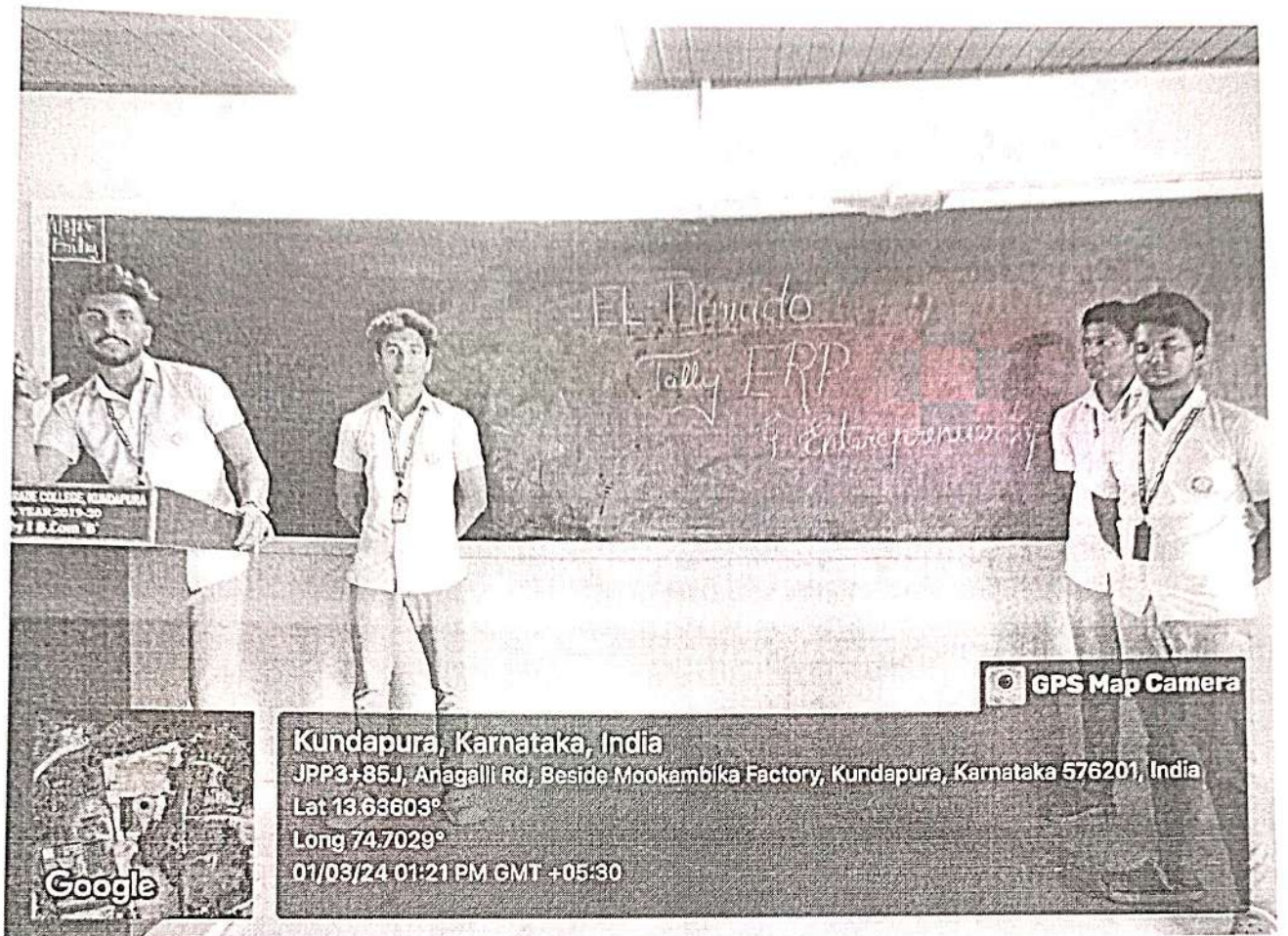
Topic: Impact Of Plastic Usage On Human Health

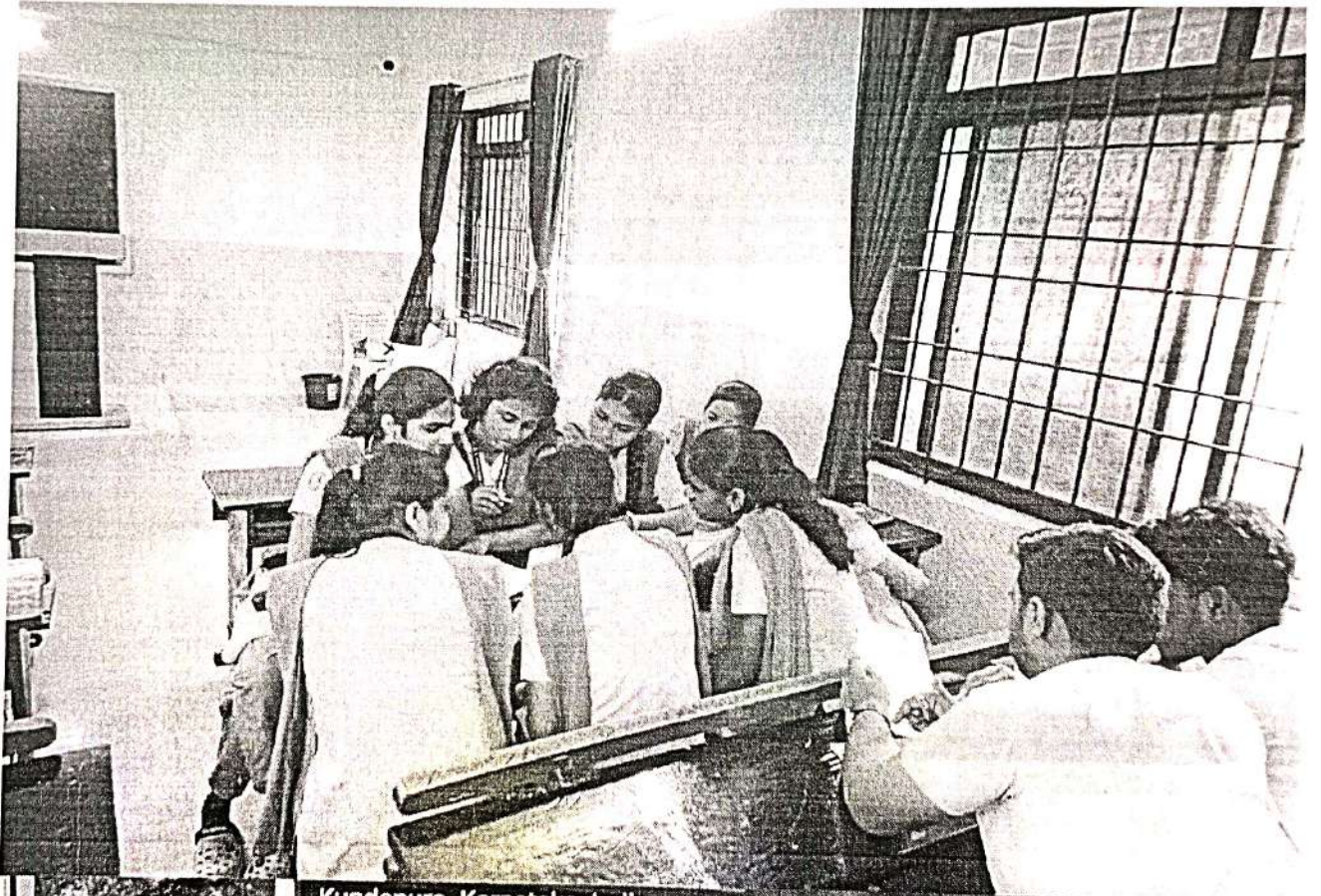

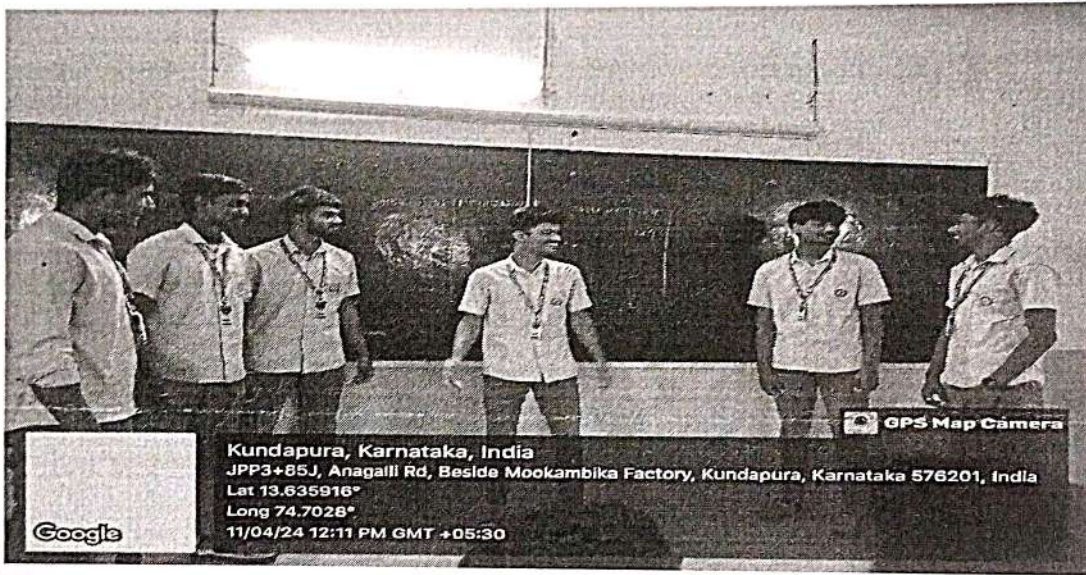
Essence of the Discussion:
