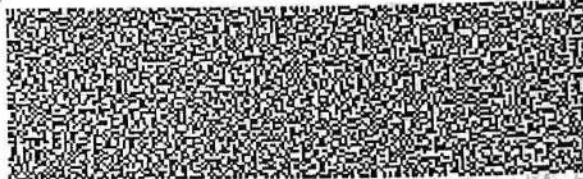
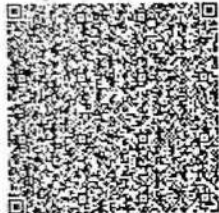

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made and entered into on 15th December 2023 at Kundapura;

BY & BETWEEN

MANIPAL TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED, a company registered under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 and validly existing under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, having registered office at Udayavani Building, Press Corner, Manipal- 576104, Karnataka, (hereinafter referred as "**MTL**", which impression shall unless repugnant to the context shall include its successors & permitted assigns) of the **FIRST PART**;

AND

DR.B.B. HEGDE FIRST GRADE COLLEGE, KUNDAPURA AFFILIATED TO MANGALORE UNIVERSITY AND COONDAPURA EDUCATION SOCIETY®, KUNDAPURA, a Society registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 having its registered office at Brahmavara, (hereinafter referred as "Institution", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context shall include its successors & assigns) of the **OTHER PART**.

MTL and Institution are collectively referred to as the "**Parties**" and individually referred to as a "**Party**".

RECITAL

WHEREAS MTL is inter alia engaged in Business of providing Skill Development Programs; and

WHEREAS Institution is inter alia engaged in the business of providing higher education; and

WHEREAS MTL and Institution is desirous of collaborating to conduct the Skill Development Programs ("Course"/"Programs") on the digital lines for the students of INSTITUTION as per the terms and conditions agreed herein.

1. Scope of MOU

Both the Parties under this MOU have agreed to collaborate with each other to provide the following certificate courses in areas such as e-Commerce Solutions, Digital Retail Experiences, Packing Design, 3D & CGI Renderings, Branding Solutions, Digital Training, Custom Digital Platforms, Video Production, AR Solutions, Web Development, Interactive Content, Social Media Content, Creative Designs, App Development, and Custom Technology Solutions by spreading over different semesters of the Degree and Master Programs. The Course details are as follows:

1. Basics of Instructional Design (Instructional Designing - Part 1) (8 to 12 weeks)
2. The ADDIE Model Implementation (Instructional Designing - Part 2) (4 to 6 weeks)
3. Digital Marketing (8 to 10 weeks)
4. Advance Excel (8 to 10 weeks)



5. Image Editing & Creativity (10 to 12 weeks)
6. Advance PowerPoint (8 to 10 weeks)
7. Motion Graphics (10 to 12 weeks)
8. Graphic Designing (12 to 14 weeks)
9. UI Design/UX Design (12 to 14 weeks)
10. Content Writing (12 to 14 weeks)
11. Data Analyst (12 to 14 weeks)
12. Project Management (12 to 14 weeks)

2. Institution Responsibilities

- a. The role of INSTITUTION is to provide a structured learning environment with a curriculum that is designed to prepare students for the workforce and also to allocate coordination resources/labs and facilities that are equipped with computer/internet and power backup facilities.
- b. Allotment of the classroom for theory sessions.
- c. Providing computer lab with specific hardware and software applications.
- d. Sitting arrangements for 30 students per batch.
- e. Assist MTL to conduct the practical exams after completing the program delivery.
- f. Awarding of certificates to the students (hard copy or softcopy).
- g. Monitoring theory and practical sessions at INSTITUTION.
- h. Course completion certificates will be issued by INSTITUTION.

List of Infrastructure to be provided by INSTITUTION:

- i. Classroom teaching requires a variety of infrastructures to support the learning process. Some of the key infrastructures required for classroom teaching include:
- j. Classroom for teaching theory, should be well-lit, spacious, and equipped with comfortable seating and desks.
- k. Audio-Visual Equipment: This can include projectors, whiteboards, and speakers, which are used to enhance the learning experience.
- l. Computers and internet access.
- m. Lab facilities to conduct the hands-on practical sessions.
- n. A library facility with suggested reference books
- o. Administrative and Support Services (career services, which provide students with important information and support throughout their academic careers).
- p. Required software packages will be owned and arranged by INSTITUTION.
- q. Class timings: Every week four hours of teaching. One-hour theory. Two hours of practical's/hands-on sessions.
- r. Teaching mode: Classroom teaching

- i. The reference study materials will be provided in digital formats.
- j. Reference reading materials shall be provided in digital formats (word/PDFs/PPT) slides

Medium of Instruction

- k. The medium of instruction is only English. The course material will also be in English. The reference study materials will be provided in digital formats (Word/PDF).

4. Intellectual Property Rights

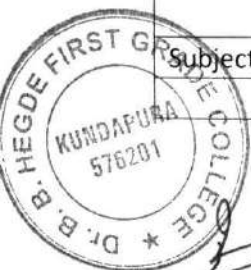

6. Commercial Terms

- The fee payable by the students is Rs. 3500/- per certificate program.
- MTL shall raise an invoice for Rs. 3500/- + GST per student of Saint Mary's Syrian College.
- Payment is subject to the deduction of tax at source as per the Income Tax Act.
- Before the start of a batch, MTL will raise a 100% advance invoice before starting the training program.
- For short-term online certificate courses, the fees range from INR 399/- to INR 699/-.



7. Mutual Warranties

Each Party represents and warrants that: (i) it has the full corporate right, power and authority to enter into this MOU and perform its obligations hereunder, (ii) its performance of this MOU, and the other Party's exercise of such other Party's rights under this MOU, will not conflict with or result in a breach or violation of any of the terms or provisions or constitute a default under any other agreement by which it is bound; and (iii) when executed and delivered, this MOU will constitute a legal, valid and binding obligation enforceable against a Party in accordance with its terms.

8. Confidentiality

- a) Institution and MTL shall each: (i) hold all Confidential Information (as defined below) supplied by the disclosing Party ("Discloser") to the receiving Party ("Recipient") or otherwise acquired by the Recipient in connection with this MoU in confidence using the same degree of care it uses to protect its own confidential information, but not less than a reasonable degree of care; (ii) not disclose the Discloser's Confidential Information to third parties without the express written consent of the Discloser; and (iii) not use the Discloser's Confidential Information except to perform its obligations or, to exercise its rights, under this MoU.
- b) The foregoing obligations of confidentiality and non-use shall not apply with respect to information that: (a) was known to the Recipient at time of disclosure as evidenced by written records; (b) is already publicly available or becomes publicly available through no fault of the Recipient; (c) is independently developed by Recipient without use of the Discloser's Confidential Information as evidenced by written records; or (d) is disclosed to Recipient by a third-party with no known duty of confidentiality to Discloser.
- c) Recipient shall have the right to disclose Confidential Information to its employees, officers, directors, subsidiaries, representatives, agents, contractors, and consultants (collectively "Representatives") but only as reasonably necessary to facilitate the use and performance of the Subscription Services or to otherwise perform Recipient's obligations pursuant to this MoU. Representatives shall be bound by written obligations of confidentiality and non-use at least as restrictive as the terms of this MoU. Recipient shall be responsible for any breach of this MoU by its Representatives.
- d) In the event that Recipient becomes legally compelled (by applicable law, interrogatories, requests for information or documents, subpoena, civil investigative demand or similar process) or a regulatory authority or other governmental entity requests Recipient to disclose any of Discloser's Confidential, Recipient shall provide the Discloser with prompt written notice of such request(s) (provided the Recipient is legally permitted to provide such notice) so that the Discloser may seek an appropriate protective order and/or waive Recipient's compliance with the provisions of this MoU. The Recipient shall only furnish that portion of Confidential Information that, in the reasonable opinion of Recipient's legal counsel, is legally required to be furnished.
- e) Upon the termination or expiration of this MoU, Recipient shall return or destroy all of the Discloser's Confidential Information. If the Confidential Information is destroyed, Recipient shall have an authorized representative certify as to the same.

For purposes of this MoU, "Confidential Information" shall mean all information of any kind related to this MoU, including without limitation, information owned or possessed by Discloser or



any of its affiliates, regarding its business, products, services, strategies, technical information, intellectual property, trade secrets, software and related code, design and architecture, developments, drawings, schematics, specifications, documentation, know how, ideas, concepts, inventions, research, techniques, processes, data, financial information, pricing information, sales information, or information of or about, or the identity of, employees, customers, or suppliers

- g) Notwithstanding the foregoing, Confidential Information does not include any data or information which: (i) is known to the recipient prior to its receipt from the disclosing party, provided that such data or information is not known by the recipient to be subject to another confidentiality MoU of which the provider is a party; (ii) is known to the public prior to its receipt by the recipient; (iii) after such receipt, becomes available to the public other than as a result of a disclosure by the recipient of any of its directors, officers, employees or agents; or (iv) can be shown by the recipient to have been independently developed by that party prior to execution of this MoU.

9. Term and Termination

- a) Unless terminated sooner as provided herein, the term of this MoU shall commence on the date first set forth above and shall continue for a period of one (1) year.
- b) Either Party may terminate this MoU upon written notice (a) if the other Party has materially breached a term of this MoU and failed to cure such breach within thirty (30) days of receipt of written notice of the breach by the non-breaching Party (which notice shall specify the nature of such breach in reasonable detail); or (b) if the other Party: (i) becomes insolvent; (ii) files a petition, or has a petition filed against it, under any laws relating to bankruptcy or insolvency; or (iii) ceases to carry on business in the ordinary course.
- c) Either Party may terminate this MoU with or without cause by giving 60 day's written notice to the other.
- d) Rights and obligations which by their very nature are intended to survive shall survive the termination of this MoU.

10. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

The validity, Interpretation and performance of this MOU shall be governed by the laws of India. Any dispute with relation to this MOU shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Udupi, Karnataka.

11. General Provisions

- a) **Assignment.** Neither this MoU nor any right or obligation hereunder shall be assigned or delegated, in whole or part, by either party without the prior express written consent of the other party, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed. Provided, however, that either party may, without the written consent of the other party, transfer and assign its interest in this MoU to any entity: (i) acquiring all or substantially all of its assets in one or a series of related transactions; or (ii) surviving a merger with or resulting from its reorganization.


Severability. If any provision of this MoU is held to be invalid or unenforceable by any judgment of a tribunal of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this MoU shall not be affected by such



judgment, and the MoU shall be carried out as nearly as possible according to its original terms and intent.

- c) **Entire MoU/Survival.** This MoU contains the entire contractual agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all oral understandings, representations, prior discussions and preliminary agreements including any letter of intent executed by the parties. This MoU may be amended only in writing signed by both parties.
- d) **No Waiver.** The failure of either party to enforce, or the delay by either party in enforcing, any of its rights under this MoU will not be deemed to be a waiver or modification by such party of any of its other rights.
- e) **Counterparts.** This MoU may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. This MoU may be executed electronically with binding force and effect.
- f) **Independent Contractors.** The parties' relationship is that of independent contractors, and neither party is an agent or representative of the other. Neither party will represent to any third party that it has, any authority to act on behalf of the other party.
- g) **Non-Solicitation.** During the Term and for one (1) year thereafter, each party shall not, directly or indirectly, solicit the employment or other engagement of any employee or individual independent contractor or consultant of the other Party.

Preamble:

WHEREAS MSDC has established eighteen state-of-the-art skill schools equipped with latest machines and staffed with highly qualified and trained skill faculty and BBHFGC College is a well-established prominent college offering undergraduate programs in different streams.

WHEREAS, both parties recognize the importance of enhancing the employability and skills of undergraduate students.

WHEREAS, both parties acknowledge the mutual benefits of collaboration in enhancing the skill education landscape and preparing students for the demands of the digital age and industrial requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to enter this MoU to establish a framework for cooperation in providing skill education to undergraduate students.

Objectives:

1. To enhance the employability skills of BBHFGC College students through skill development programs.
2. To promote collaboration in the design, development, and delivery of skill-oriented courses.
