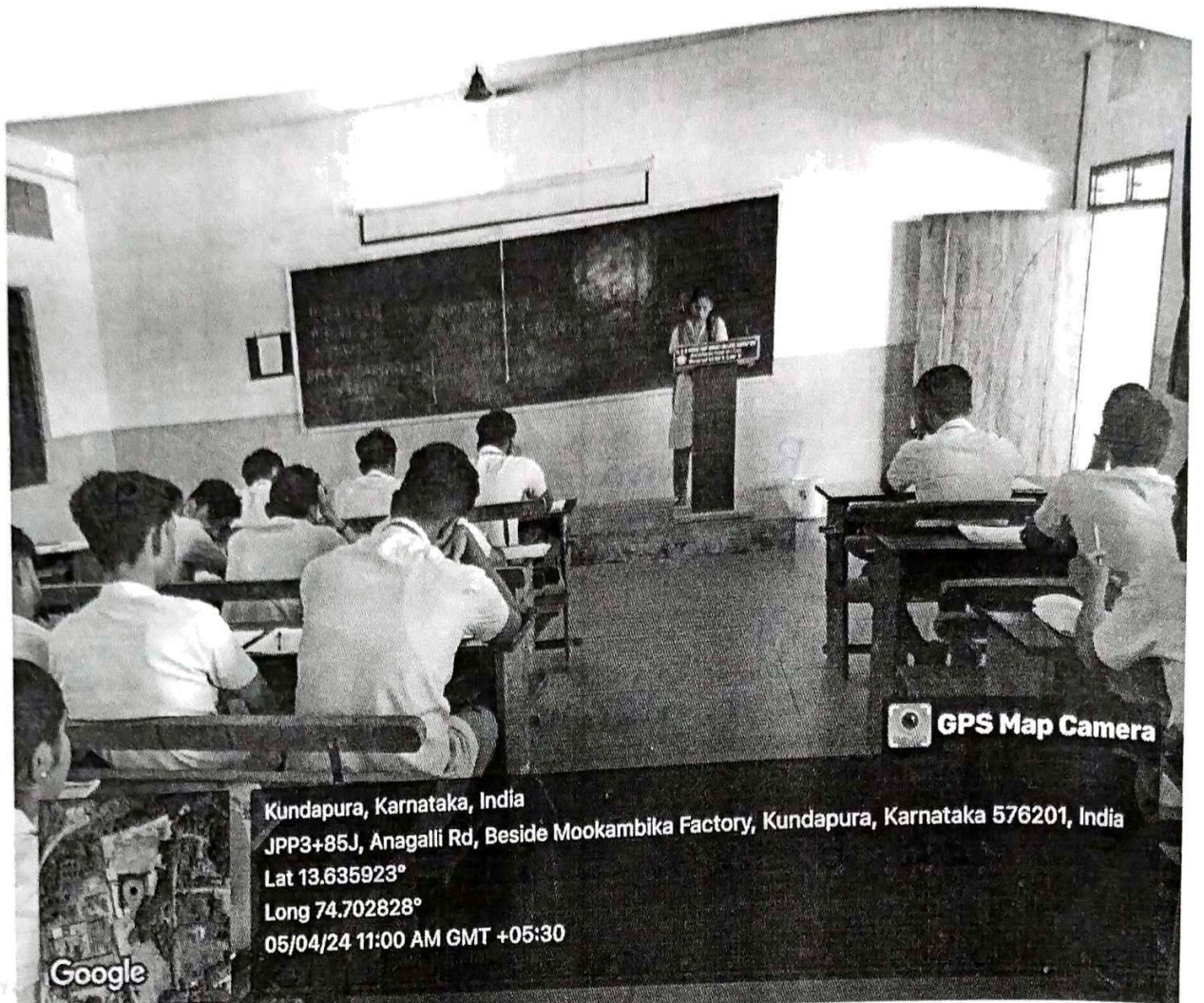

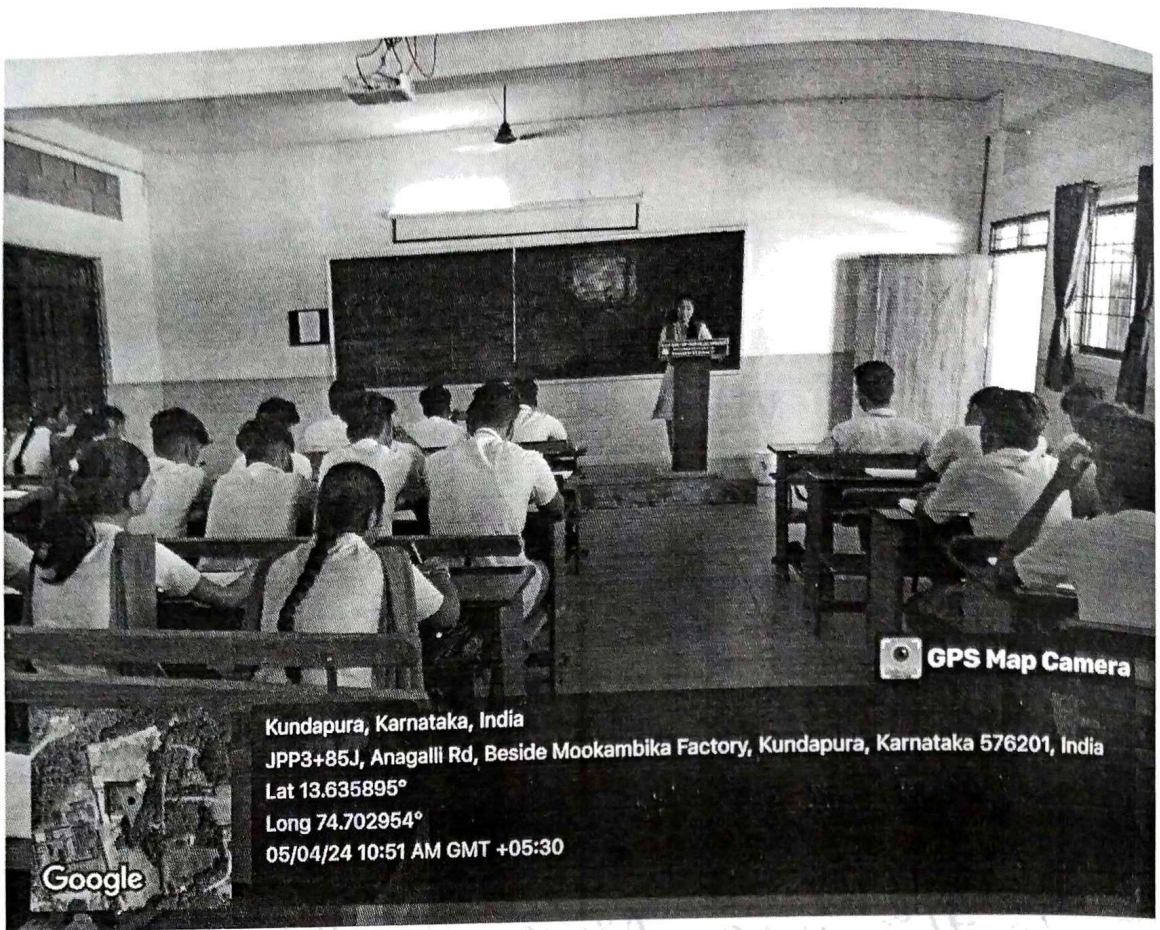

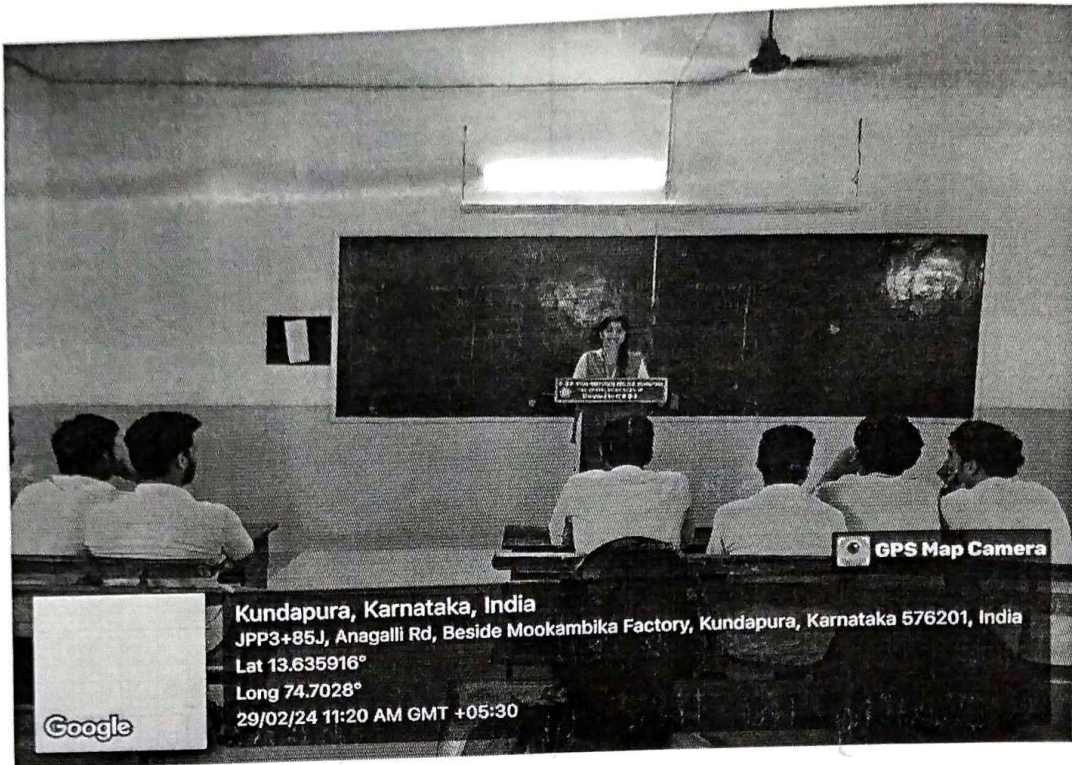
Topic: Justify the title Gharchar Ghochar by Vivek Shanbhag

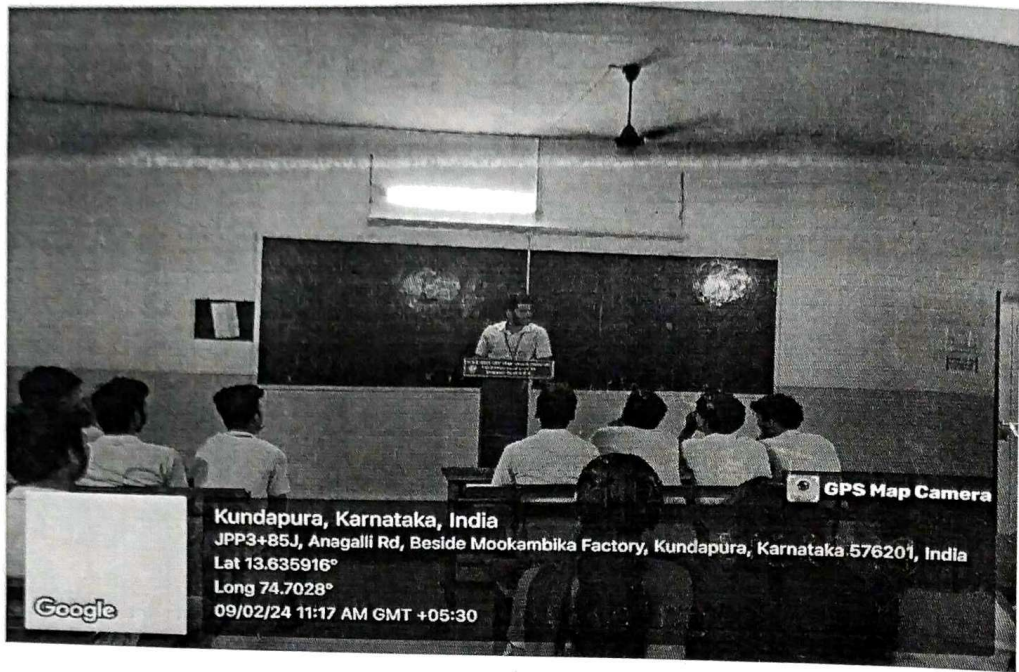
Topic: Character sketch of Rosemary Fell
