Dr. B. B. Hegde First Grade College, Kundapura, affiliated to Mangalore University, was established in the year 2010 under the aegis of Coondapur Education Society (R.) with the munificence of Chief benefactor Late Smt. Vishalakshi B. Hegde to provide quality education to the students from the poor and marginalized sections of the society at an affordable cost and thus build the future generation for a better tomorrow.

The College was started by educational stalwart, Sri B. M. Sukumar Shetty, MLA of Byndoor Constituency that has created a niche for itself among the Colleges that are affiliated to Mangalore University, for its prominent and notable performances in academics, Literature, sports, culture and many other fields of performances, which has seen tremendous growth from its inception in 2010 with a mere 130 students to 1157 students at present.


